The Salmon Recovery Technical and Citizen Committee was established for providing a citizen- based evaluation of the projects proposed to promote salmon habitat, in accordance with RCW 77.85.050 . Membership includes 19 voting members representative of interests of counties, cities, conservation districts, tribes, environmental groups, business interests, landowners, citizens, volunteer groups, regional fish enhancement groups, and other habitat interest. The Board of Island County Commissioners appoints the nine citizen members and shall initially serve staggered 4-year terms.
